You will be able to share the love of Christ and the outdoors with 6 to 10 children between the ages of 7 and 11 by being their counselor. Camp Penuel is a non-profit, non-denominational camp which offers FREE camp to at-risk children. The Central camp is located at Lake Killarney in Ironton, Missouri, another is in Esparza, Costa Rica and our camp located in Eldred, Pennsylvania. For many of the children it is their first time they have been out of the city and get to enjoy a week of camp life.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT AT CAMP:

- Expect to follow our camp schedule
- Expect to be busy from morning to night
- Expect to be like the mom & dad to 6 to 10 children that are between the ages of 7-11
- Expect to sleep in the cabin with the children
- Expect to participate in all activities with your kids
- Expect to be with your campers 24 hours a day
- Expect plenty of good food
- Expect warm weather, but even though it is summer it can get quite cool here at night
- Expect to be tired by the end of the day
- Expect it to be a great week
- Expect to be an example of Christ and to see God change your camper's lives

- 5:00PM: Dinner
- 6:00PM: Crafts or Activities
- 7:00PM: Evening Chapel
- 7:45PM: Evening Activity
- 8:45PM: Evening Snack / Camp fire
- 10:00PM: All Campers in Cabins
- 11:00PM: Lights Out

- ✗ Money (you will not need any)
- ✗ Snacks (no food allowed in cabins)
- ✗ Portable video game devices
- ✗ Anything you don't want to lose/be damaged
- ✗ Anything inappropriate for a Christian Camp
- ✗ ***Don't bring anything that will distract you from your responsibility of supervising the campers in your group***

COUNSELOR CELL PHONE POLICY

We understand that our cell phones are often our "lifeline." We ask that while you are here at camp, your cell phone is only used when you are on break. We ask that you wear a watch to keep track of time instead of your phone. In addition, you cannot take photos of campers unless you are asked to do so by the Directors. Your priority is the campers!

LOCATION

Camp Penuel East is located in Eldred, Pennsylvania.
